SUBJECT: FINAL EXAM SCHEDULE

Exam Schedule:

Wednesday and Thursday, May 15 and 16- Seniors will take English and Government exams in their regular classes. Seniors will continue to attend school the following week if they have exams they are required to take.

Friday, May 17- Senior breakfast and graduation practice

Monday, May 20 and Tuesday, May 21- Regular school days

Wednesday, May 22- Exams will be given 1A, 2A, 4A during regular classes.

Thursday, May 23- Exams will be given 1B, 2B, 4B during regular classes.

Wednesday and Thursday students report to HOMEROOM for 3rd period and lunch. Lunch schedule to be determined.

Friday, May 24th- 3rd-period exam will be given 9:05-10:40. After the exam, we will have a field day and lunches.

On **Friday, May 24th**, students will report directly to their 3rd-period class for their final exam.

Exam Exemptions:

Any student who meets one of the following criteria shall be exempt from the final examination or culminating activity in a class:

A senior student who has a "B" or above cumulative course average.

A student enrolled in an Advanced Placement (AP) class who takes the AP exam.

A student who has successfully completed a sequence of Career and Technical Education (CTE) courses and passes a corresponding credentialing assessment or a student enrolled in a course containing a corresponding credentialing assessment who has previously passed the assessment and has shown academic achievement in the course by earning a "B" or above cumulative course average.

A student enrolled in a course containing an End of Course SOL test or alternate SOL test who passes the test. (To be exempt from the English 11 exam, students must pass both the Reading and Writing End of Course SOL test or alternate SOL test).

A student enrolled in a course containing an End of Course SOL who has passed all required End of Course SOLs in the same content area and has shown academic achievement in the course by earning a "B" or above cumulative course average.

As in any situation, if the student wants and chooses to take the exam even if they are exempt, they may do so to improve their grade.

Any student who needs to pass the exam to raise their yearly average to pass the course must take the exam.

SOL INCENTIVES

- Any student who passes "Advanced" (500 or Above) on the End of Course SOL test will receive a 100 on their final exam in addition to being exempt.
- For English Reading and Writing:
 - Students must pass both Reading and Writing to be exempt.
 - Students who pass advanced (500 or Above) on both reading and writing will receive a 100 on their final exam and a 100 on a summative assignment for the 4th nine weeks grading period in addition to being exempt.
 - Students who pass advanced on either reading or writing, not both, will receive a 100 on their final exam in addition to being exempt.

IMPORTANT:

Students who will be absent from school due to illness should have a parent/guardian contact the school **by the end of the day for the missed exam(s)** in order to reschedule the exam . **If parent/guardian contact is not received, a "1" will be entered as the exam grade for the missed exam(s).**
